Animal Communicator Special Guest Appearance

A former wildlife sanctuary zookeeper and now a sought after animal communicator, **Amanda De Warren** is doing a special guest appearance at **Harbour Town Shopping Centre on the Gold Coast for the Saturday 13th August from 12.30pm.**

Ms De Warren is one of **Australia's leading animal communicators** and **highly respected animal behaviourists**. Amanda can communicate with animals alive, missing and passed over.

Supported by Harbour Town Centre Management, Pet Suppliers Direct and Animal Welfare League of QLD, Amanda will do two half hour shows where she will share her experiences and understandings giving you expert tips on how to have the best possible loving and calming relationship with your pet over their lifetime. It also will be a unique and exclusive opportunity for you to experience a peaceful re-connection with family pets that have passed over or that could still be alive but need to pass on a message to the owner.

After each show Amanda will meet guests personally so they can ask a question about a family pet, all Amanda asks if you can bring a photo of the pet. Raffle tickets will also be sold on the day to help raise money for **Animal Welfare League of Qld**.

"I've always had a great affiliation with animals, but I realised I had a communication gift about eight years ago," Ms De Warren said.

"I am able to tune into particular animals when I need to, the living and animals that have passed away."

"One client's cat had been missing for some time, as soon as I connected to the cat, it told me it had been stolen by people who had lived a few doors down."

"I have helped in many cases, especially in zoos to help gain a better understanding of animals needs though body language and channelling."

"It can be very effective and often saves people putting their animals through expensive and painful tests, as I can immediately see what the problem is, what they feel, like or don't like, it," Ms De Warren said.

"What I do now is help people understand their animals, whether a dog, cat, horse... and for some, help give them closure if their animal has passed away," she said.

"I now have more than 50 pet channelling clients a week, it's becoming very popular, even more than human channelling."

Queensland based Amanda De Warren has worked with more than **5000 national and international clients**. She has **appeared as a guest on over fifteen radio stations** around Australia, a **Current Affair**, **Today Tonight**, **Talk to the Animals** and has featured in more than **70 national newspapers and magazines** including *The Courier Mail* and *Sunday Mail*.
